Subject: Withdrawing the condition to pass IT literacy course for issuing National Trade Certificate (NTC) to trainees of ITIs.

Sir/ Madam,

Your Kind attention is invited to this office letter No. DGE&T 19/19/2010 – CD dated 15/10/2010 by which it was communicated that NTC shall be issued to a candidate only after he/she passes the IT literacy course. It has been brought to the notice of the Government that a very large percentage of candidates have passed all papers other than IT literacy course and are facing difficulty in getting NTC.

After a careful consideration of various aspects it has now been decided that the trainees who have received requisite training in affiliated trade/unit and passed all other papers except IT Literacy course of All India Trade Test (AITT) are entitled for NTC.


